



FISH:	<p>Grayling - The stunningly delicate sail fin of the Grayling is it's most prominent feature. The Grayling is only found in the most pristine , cold, clear and well oxygenated waters.</p> <p>Arctic Grayling (<i>Thymallus arcticus</i>) ...With out a doubt, one of the most enthralling salmonids is the very pretty #arcticgrayling . The large dorsal fin captures the eye of novice and seasoned line-whippers alike.</p>
ROD:	5-7 WT 9 ft Thomas and Thomas fly rods (I use a 7 wt due to catching jack (young king) salmon to hefty rainbows and other species in the same pools) In czech nymphing a 10 foot 5 weight is great.
REEL:	Matching the rod wt I use Abel reels or Ross reels
LINE:	Cortlandline to a 7 1/2 foot cortland tapered leader to a dry fly. Nymph set up in 5x fluro-carbon is
LEADER:	Above.
FLIES:	Dry's and wets – the same for trout
